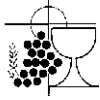


**STEWARDSHIP**

Join us while we say the Rosary before the weekend Masses and after the weekday Masses.



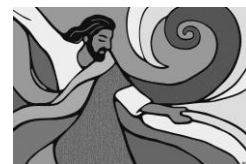
**Happy Mother's Day**
