Bat exclusion at ICC

We have bats in the attic of ICC church, rectory, office, and St. Anthony Center. The bat expert said this is normal for old buildings like ours and he is pretty certain many of the other old churches in the area have bats living in their attic. Bats can get in holes as small as ½ inch by ½ inch. Our buildings certainly have lots of holes, cracks, and even gaps in the roofs and eaves. The bat expert will set traps allowing the bats to escape but not come back in, then seal up the holes. This will take approximately two weeks and will require a lift onsite. You will see this lift arrive this upcoming Thursday, Oct 15th. Please be careful if you see the batman working on the lift. Unfortunately, I don't think he will be wearing his batsuit!
